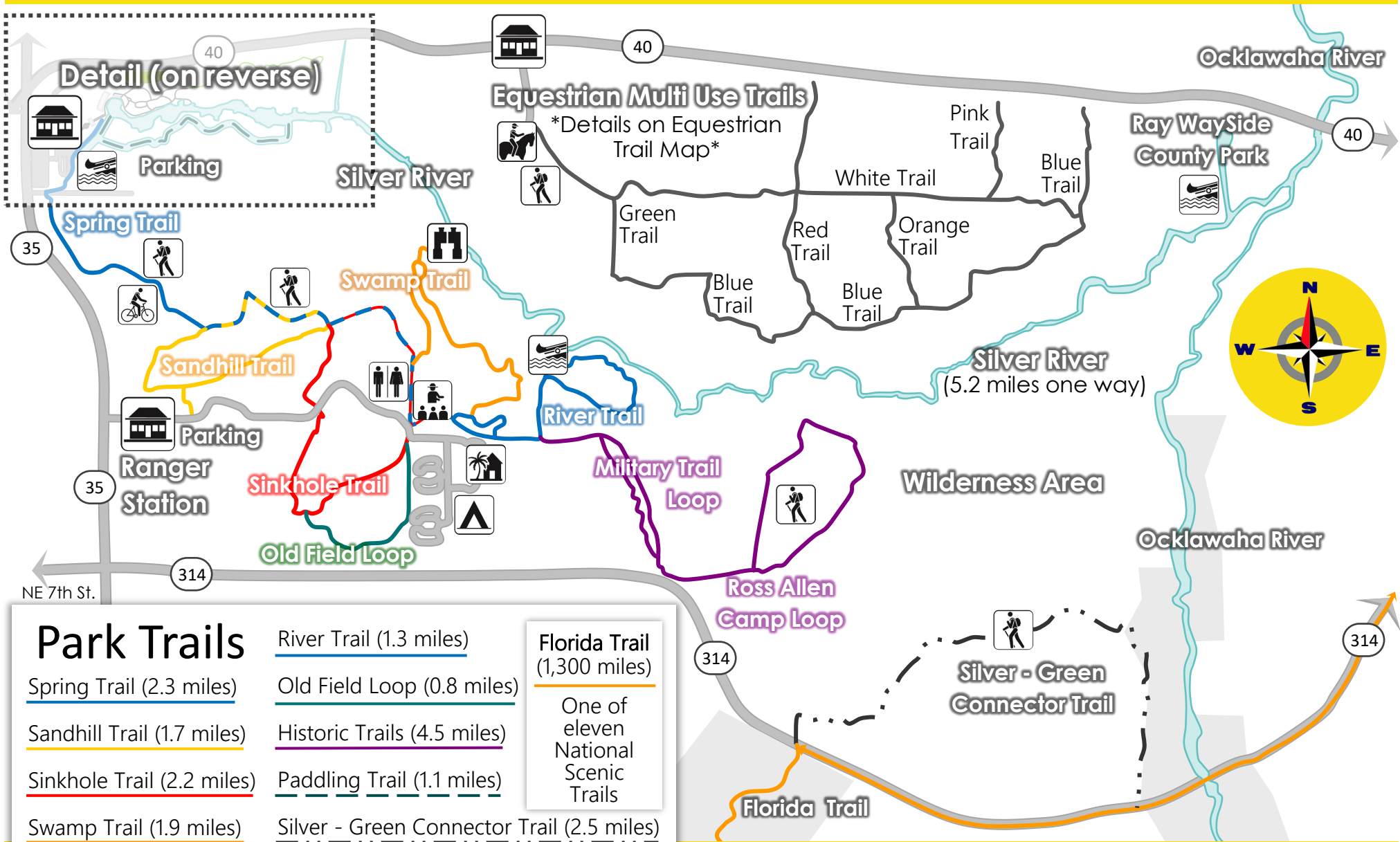

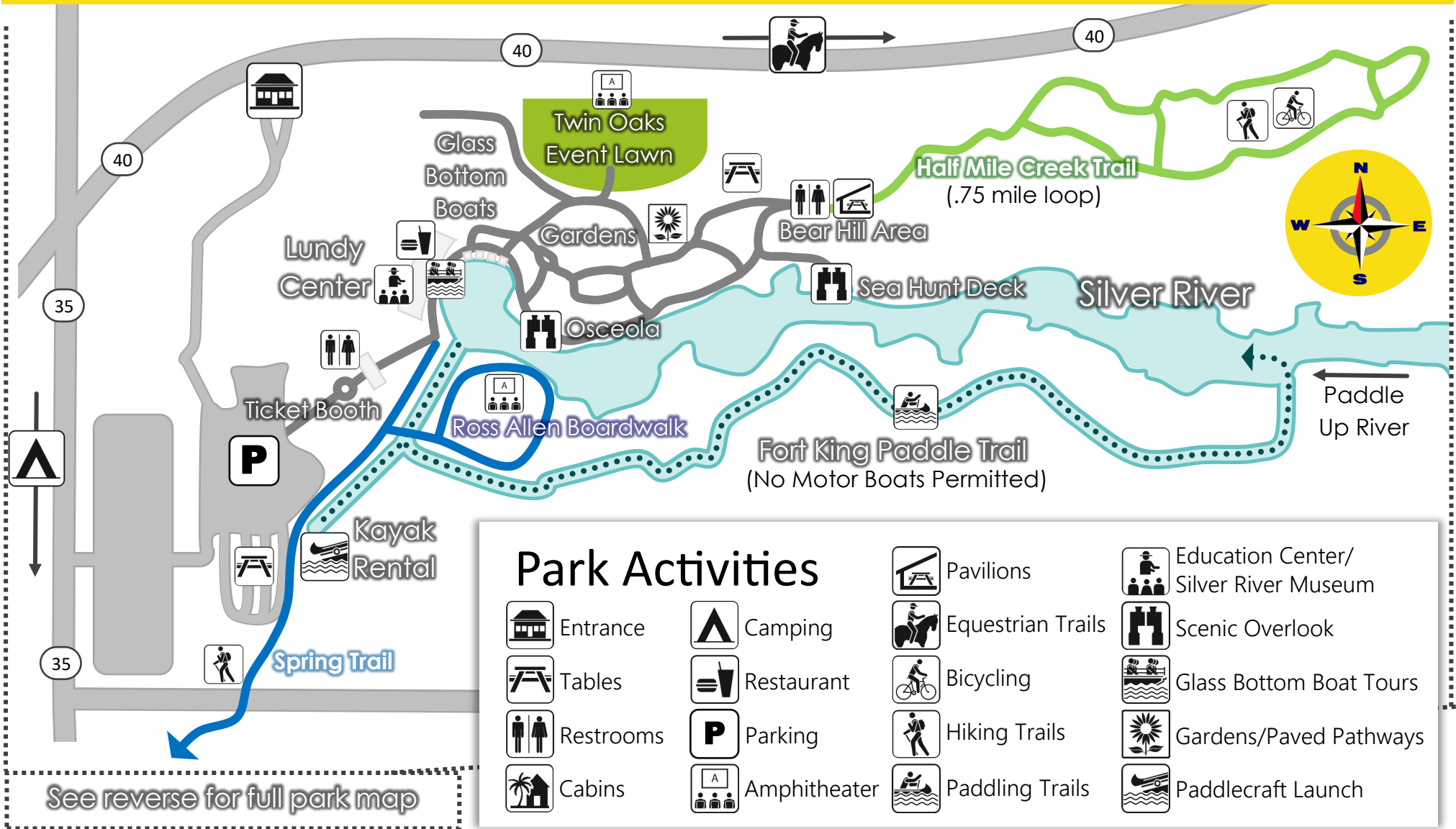

Encounters with wildlife may occur. Please respect wild animals, they can be dangerous to humans and are often protected by law. Do not approach, feed, or harass the wildlife in any way.
